

Learning our Facts

Make your own basic fact card for each of your basic facts

$$4 + 3 = 7$$

$$6 \times 4 =$$

Write each of your facts three times.

$$5 \times 6 = 30$$

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Trace over it in different colours.

Get some counters and use them to show each of your basic facts. Draw what it looks like in your book next to your fact.



$$3 \times 4 = 12$$

Grab a buddy and get them to test you with your fact cards.

$$7 \times 3 =$$

Grab a buddy and chant your basic facts out together three times.



$2 \times 6 = 12$, $2 \times 7 = 14$,
 $2 \times 8 = 16$...

Try using each of your facts to help you figure out another fact.

My fact is: $4 \times 7 = 28$

$4 \times 7 = 28$ so $5 \times 7 = 28 + 7 = 35$

My fact is: $7 + 7 = 14$

$7 + 7 = 14$ so $7 + 8 = 15$

For each of your facts...

- 1) Look at the fact
- 2) Say it out loud/whisper it.
- 3) Cover the fact
- 4) Get a picture of the fact in your head.
- 5) Write the fact
- 6) Check fact is right.
- 7) See if you can figure out your fact's family.
